AIR CONDITIONING

Broome International Airport (BIA) is proud to unveil the completion of air-conditioning works in the arrival's hall. The new ducted air-conditioning system will allow the temperature in the arrivals hall to remain at approximately 25 degrees, providing additional comfort for all arriving passengers.

BIA's Chief Executive Officer, Paul McSweeney, was extremely pleased with the upgrade and said "this adds to passenger comfort at BIA, particularly in the hotter months."
