Broome International Airport (BIA) wishes to advise that its management and operation of Djarindjin/Lombadina Airport finished on 31 January 2022.

BIA, and its associated company Peninsular Airport Management Services, have been involved in the operation and management of Djarindjin/Lombadina Airport since 2010. During this time many improvements have been made to the aerodrome and it has delivered essential refuelling and staging operations for oil and gas operators and helicopter companies with operations in the Browse Basin.

Since 2010 BIA has worked closely with the Djarindjin Aboriginal Corporation (DAC) and we are very proud of what has been achieved. The airport has, and continues to be, staffed by an all-Indigenous workforce, who do a wonderful job.

The transition to DAC managing and operating the airport from 1 February 2022 has been very smooth and we wish DAC all the very best for the future.
